Bassetlaw Museum re-opened to the public on Saturday, 1<sup>st</sup> August after many months of lockdown.



To celebrate Mayflower 400 this year they have been able to stage a special exhibition named 'Journeys' in the Percy Laws Gallery. It is their first Open Art Exhibition, attracting professional artists as well as first time exhibitors from across the District. It runs until Saturday, 10<sup>th</sup> October this year.
