

From Richard Isaac at Northern Railway:

“On Monday 30 March, a revised timetable came into operation. This followed feedback from colleagues and stakeholders, including those representing the NHS and Emergency Service key workers.

The revised timetable follows the same structure as the previous amended timetable, but includes key worker services and crew diagram changes.

Our revised timetables are working well and are helping us to continue providing a rail service across the network, whilst facing many unprecedented challenges.

We are running a timetable for Key and essential workers. It is important that we don't make judgements on what passengers do and whether they are essential or not.

Essential and Key workers are not just doctors and nurses and may not be in uniform. There are many people who are travelling for other essential roles or where they simply can't work at home.
