Revised proposal for Maumhill wind farm by EDF Energy Renewables (EDF ER)

Dear Councillor,

I am writing to invite you to a stakeholder preview event of the revised plans for our proposed wind farm on land near Sturton le Steeple.

As you will be aware, we have already withdrawn our appeal against Bassetlaw District Council's decision to refuse planning permission for our original application after the Planning Inspector indicated that the proposed revisions to the scheme could not be considered as part of the appeal.

We must therefore resubmit a new planning application and under the scheme now being proposed the original nine turbines would be reduced to seven. To provide full details of the proposals we will be hosting two days of information events for local stakeholders and residents.

A special drop in session for local councillors is being held on **Friday, 2nd May at Sturton Village Hall from 9.00am until 10.00am.**

The EDF ER team will be on hand to answer questions on the plans and special 3D visualisation technology will be available to replicate local views of the wind farm from surrounding areas.

If for any reason you are unable to make the dedicated stakeholder event, then you may be able to attend one of the public exhibition sessions that will also be taking place:

Thursday 1st May, Sturton Village Hall from 12 noon until 7.00pm;

Friday 2nd May, Sturton Village Hall, from 10.00am until 1.00pm and then at North and South Wheatley Village Hall from 3.00pm until 7.00pm

As a key stakeholder, we would be grateful if you could help make others aware of the consultation events and encourage people to get involved.
