#### The Restart Scheme

To be eligible, individuals need to have been out of work for between
12 and 18 months.

All referrals via Jobcentre Plus.

• 15,000 individuals are projected to be supported by the scheme across Nottinghamshire.

 Tailored support based on referrals to local provision via the Community Partnership Network

Place based response to employment and skills needs

# Community Partnership Network (CPN)

- Network of local partners to provide support to Restart participants
- Facilitating referrals, aligning provision and funding services where required
- Includes skills providers, drug and alcohol addiction services, debt and housing advice organisations, mental health service providers, etc
- Potential to identify gaps in funded local provision and commission new initiatives as required



## Joining the CPN

- Organisation completes an EOI and submits to Maximus
- EOI includes Menu of Service for both funded and non-funded provision as well as delivery locations
- Maximus complete a Due Diligence and Risk Assessment procurement process
- Organisation approved and added to CPN able to receive direct referrals for both funded and non-funded provision
- Organisation able to directly invoice Maximus for non-funded provision once on the CPN



### Local Engagement

- Monthly: <u>Local Engagement Meeting</u> provide updates on Restart Scheme, share information on potential for alignment and co-development of solutions to respond to local employment and skills challenges
- Quarterly: <u>Economic Recovery Forum</u> bring together employers, LEP, LA's, college, anchor institutions to facilitate activity to support economic growth and community recovery from Covid-19
