***Local Government Reorganisation**



Overview

Local Government Reorganisation is happening in Nottinghamshire and Nottingham and now is the time to give your views, represent your community and help shape the future of services across our county.

This means that the way local councils in England are organised is being fundamentally changed for the first time in 50 years.

Currently, services are delivered in a 'two-tier' system which means that the county council and district and borough councils provide services to our community, in the city of Nottingham, one unitary authority provides services in the unitary model.

Following the 2024 White Paper on Devolution, the Government has now asked councils to work together on proposals for their areas with the aim of providing organisations that are more resource efficient, joined up and closer to communities.

Engagement with the public and businesses

As part of the planning process for Local Government Reorganisation (LGR) all nine Nottinghamshire Councils will share information about the options being explored and ask you to share your views.

From 4 August to 14 September, engagement will take place via an online survey which will be shared through various media, and social channels along with in person opportunities to complete the survey. Some councils may also distribute the survey to every household by post; however, most local councils will be reliant on a digital-led process.

Why this matters

LGR will change how councils work and how services are delivered. This affects every resident, business and organisation across all nine council areas in Nottingham and Nottinghamshire.

Options being considered include expanding Nottingham City and combining councils into new authorities.

Why now

Engagement is open from 4 August until 15 September. Responses will help shape the final submission to Government on 28 November.






