In January 2024, Haji Mohammed Siddique returned to his Creator. Soon after, his family established the HMS Project and made a commitment to complete a 5-year international charity project as a Sadaqah Jariyah in honour of his memory.

The aim is for the volunteers to assume long-term responsibility and create a lasting welfare programme benefiting both those who have passed on and those who remain. The HMS project allows members from our community to donate and support various projects as a means of Sadaqah Jariyah for their loved ones.

AL MADINA VILLAGE

An entire village consisting of 100 Homes, 6 businesses, a mosque & community centre, in Sindh, Pakistan.

HMS 1 - TUK TUK CHALLENGE

6 Tuk Tuk's distributed to poor families in Kashmir, Pakistan

+ A water project serving six villages

HMS 2 - TUK TUK CHALLENGE

7 Tuk Tuk's distributed to poor families in Multan, Sindh Pakistan

+ installation of 450 water pumps

AL MADINA VILLAGE

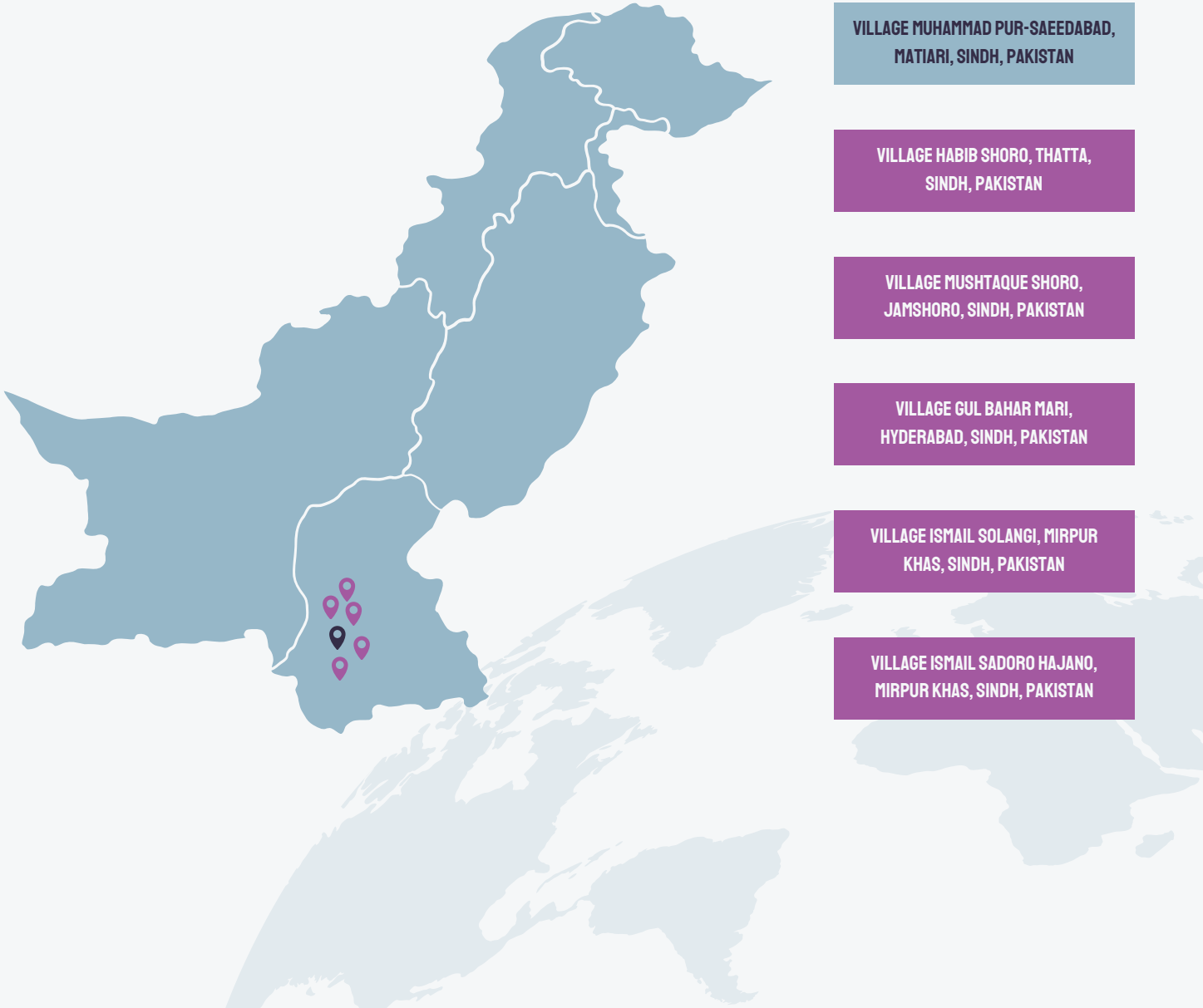
SINDH, PAKISTAN

HMSI - TUK TUK CHALLENGE

KASHMIR, PAKISTAN

A team of 7 travelled to Pakistan, where they donated 6 brand new Tuk Tuk's, which they drove across Kashmir over 6 days. The Tuk Tuk's were then gifted to poor families in Arja to help them earn a living and break the cycle of poverty.

A water project serving six entire villages and a mosque was installed.

Additionally, 100 water pumps were installed in various poor and rural communities in Pakistan.



HMS2-TUKTUK CHALLENGE

MULTAN, PAKISTAN

A team of 15 travelled to Pakistan, where they donated 7 brand new Tuk Tuk's, which they then drove approx 650 miles across Punjab.

The Tuk Tuk's were then gifted to poor families in Multan to help them earn a living and break the cycle of poverty.

Additionally, inspired by the previous year water pump installations, the project undertook the installation of 450 new water pumps in memory of loved ones of members of the Al Madina community, of which 250 have been installed.

ENHANCED DBS CERTIFICATE

MANDATORY - Certificate must be provided.

Due to the type of work that will be carried out at the Baby Care Home.
