

Muslim Charity UK has a visit planned to Uganda from 17th to 27th September, 2026.

The Uganda visit will give Greg and Chris Herdman an opportunity to see a broad range of Muslim Charity's humanitarian and development work in Uganda, particularly in the areas of health, education, safe water and support for vulnerable communities.

Some of the projects and areas of work you'll be visiting include:

- **Healthcare and newborn care** – supporting premature and vulnerable babies through improved neonatal facilities and lifesaving equipment at Mbale Regional Referral Hospital, alongside a mobile clinic and training facility helping extend care into communities.
- **Care for vulnerable children** – visiting a Baby Care Home in Kampala which provides abandoned babies with a safe environment, medical care, nutrition and ongoing support.
- **Education** – visiting primary schools where new classrooms have been constructed and existing facilities renovated, helping provide safer and more suitable learning environments for thousands of children.
- **Safe water** – seeing clean-water initiatives providing communities with more sustainable access to safe drinking water.
- **Refugee and humanitarian support** – visiting Kiryandongo Refugee Settlement and seeing some of the challenges faced by refugee families, including access to food, water and other essential support.
